## **Site description:**

The main part of the site occupies the valley bottom and slopes of one of the headwaters of the River Gannel. The soils are largely derived from slatey mudstones and siltstones with bare rock in places, and there are extensive areas of mine spoil, which are vegetated to varying degrees. Newlyn Downs supports the largest area of temperate Atlantic wet heath with Dorset heath *Erica ciliaris* and cross-leaved heath *E. tetralix* in Cornwall. The site supports dry and wet heath and mire communities and stands of willow *Salix* spp. scrub.

**Qualifying habitats:** The site is designated under **article 4(4)** of the Directive (92/43/EEC) as it hosts the following habitats listed in Annex I:

- Temperate Atlantic wet heaths with *Erica ciliaris* and *Erica tetralix*. (Wet heathland with Dorset heath and cross-leaved heath).\*
- European dry heaths

Annex I priority habitats are denoted by an asterisk (\*).
