## **Citation for Special Area of Conservation (SAC)**

## Site description:

Ford Moss is a largely intact bog in undulating topography in the rain-shadow of the Cheviot Hills. Although partially drained, the re-wetted surface contains many waterlogged areas with species typical of peat-formation and water runs into the bog from the surrounding slopes Although there are drier purple moor-grass *Molinia caerulea*-dominated parts, it is considered to be predominantly active raised bog with a good depth of peat within the confining basin. Large areas are dominated by heather *Calluna vulgaris* and there are good examples of bogmoss *Sphagnum* species, areas of cotton grass *Eriophorum vaginatum* and cranberry *Vaccinium oxycoccus*.

**Qualifying habitats:** The site is designated under **article 4(4)** of the Directive (92/43/EEC) as it hosts the following habitats listed in Annex I:

• Active raised bogs\*
