Site description:

The site comprises a series of springs and associated fen along the lower slopes of Sand Dale. The springs drain into Thornton Beck which forms the eastern boundary of Eller's Wood. Rich fen vegetation follows the seepage lines from springs. Blunt-flowered rush *Juncus subnodulosus*, sharp-flowered rush *J. acutiflorus*, long-stalked yellow sedge *Carex lepidocarpa* and bryophytes form the basis of the community. Between the flushes on raised banks there is more acidic grassland amongst scattered gorse *Ulex europaeus* and hawthorn *Crataegus monogyna*. A population of Geyer's whorl snail *Vertigo geyeri* exists at this site in a tufa-rich flush.

Qualifying habitats: The site is designated under **article 4(4)** of the Directive (92/43/EEC) as it hosts the following habitats listed in Annex I:

• Petrifying springs with tufa formation (*Cratoneurion*). (Hard-water springs depositing lime)*

Qualifying species: The site is designated under article 4(4) of the Directive (92/43/EEC) as it hosts the following species listed in Annex II:

• Geyer's whorl snail Vertigo geyeri
