A map of the Somerset Levels and Moors Ramsar surface water catchment.


#### Catchment Area Update (2024)

Natural England has undertaken a review of all the Nutrient Neutrality catchment areas. This review has considered updated surface water catchment data and evidence held by both Natural England and the Environment Agency. Consideration has also been given to data and evidence provided by parties such as Local Planning Authorities. The information below summarises changes.

The update has removed a number of areas from the catchment, this change is in response to data provided by Somerset Council. The catchment is now consistent with the data published on Somerset Council's website.
