A map of the component Site of Special Scientific Interests (SSSIs) of the River Camel Special Area of Conservation (SAC).

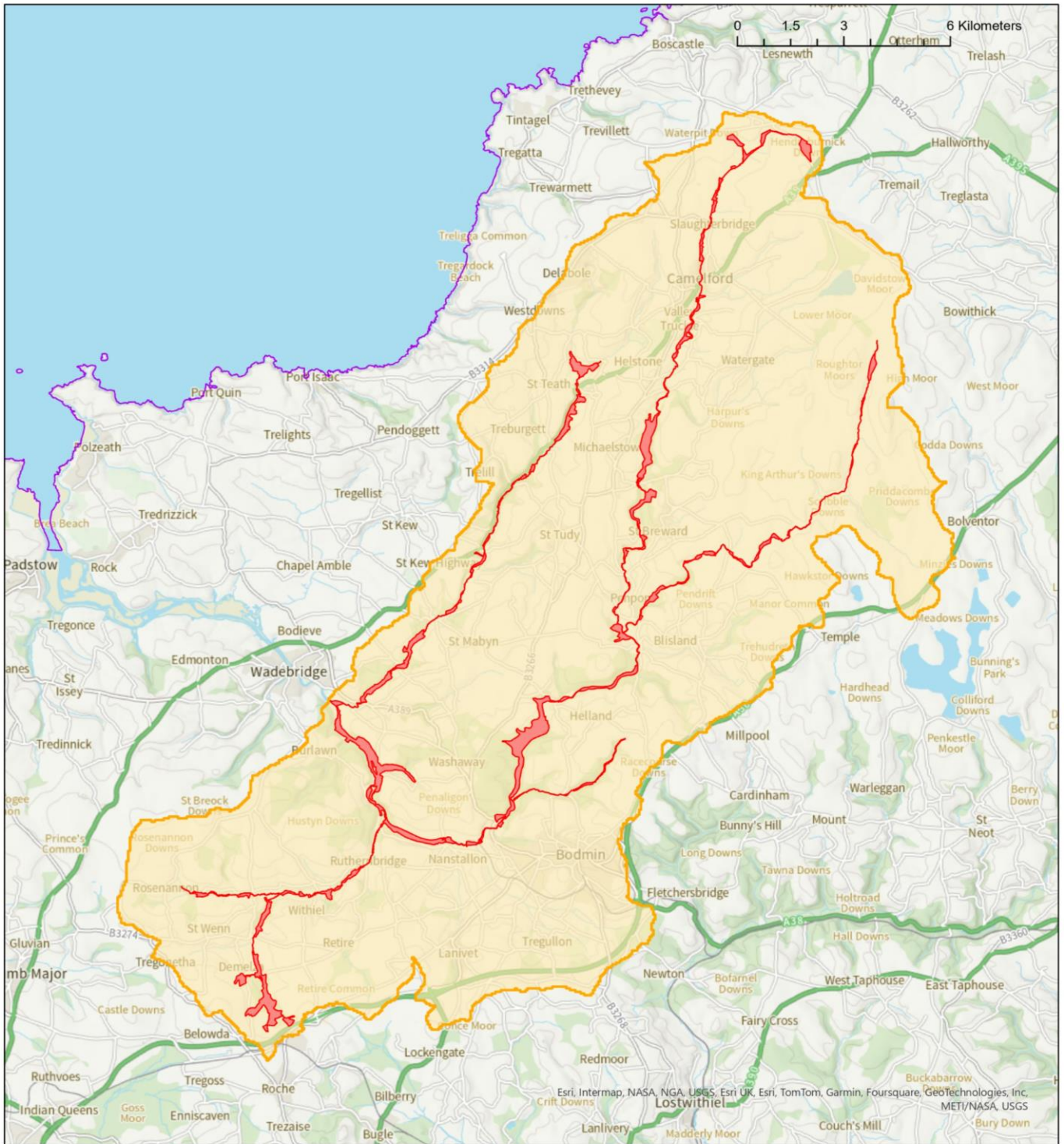
Catchment Area Update (2024)
