



Kiln Dust Containment

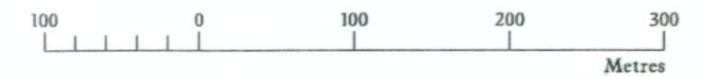
