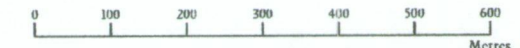

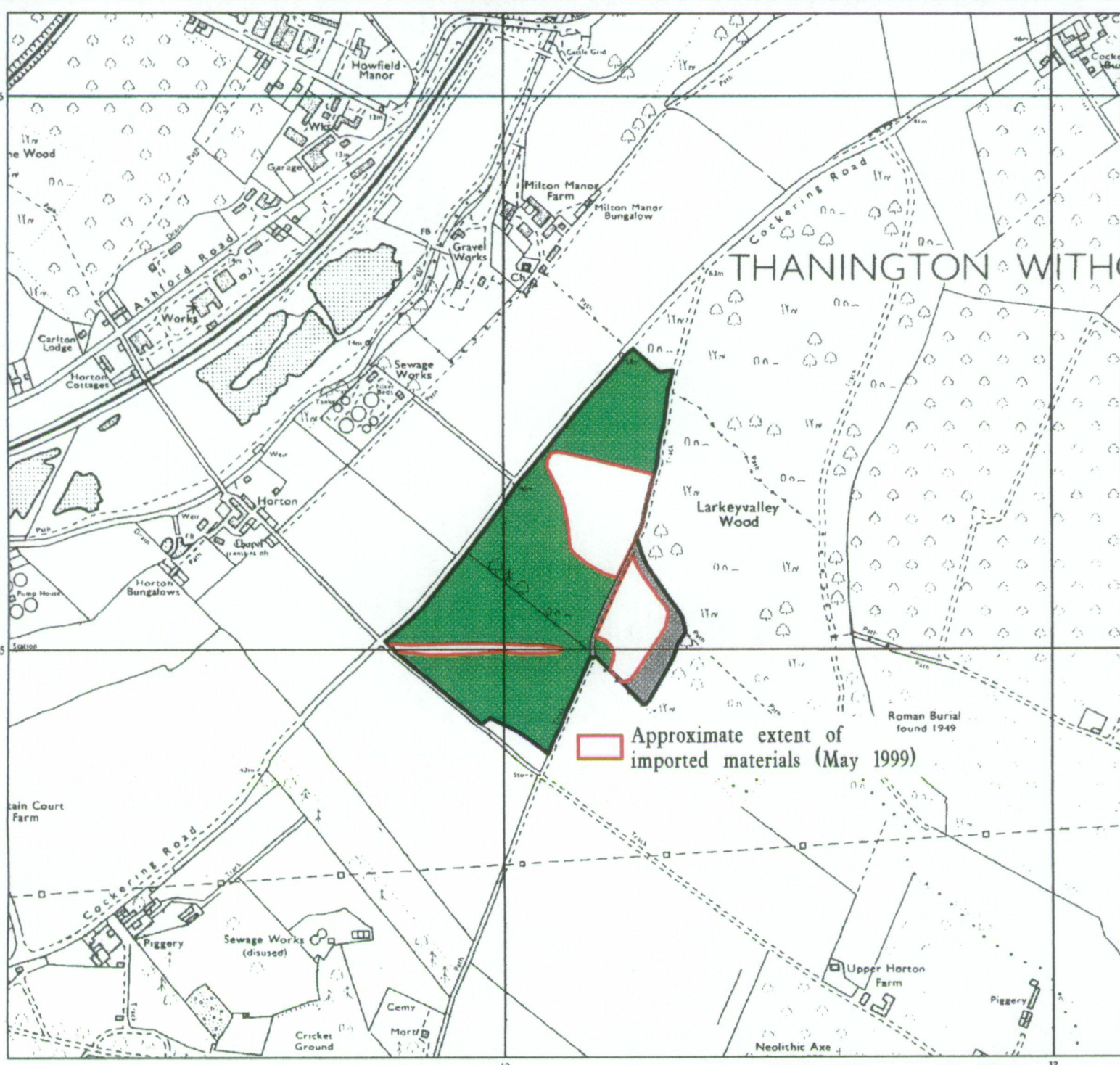

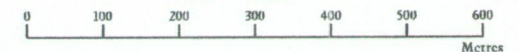
-  Location of soil pit
