- Education is required and man-made barriers removed.
- Shared use – Disabled ramblers are happy to share with everyone.
- What's the legal status of mobility scooters and footpaths and have you ever taken action with an authority? Never one done it as no money.
- Disabled ramblers don't want access to every footpath.
- Disabled ramblers 'suss' routes out. Sometimes landowners need to be spoken too, not local authorities.
- There has been no incidents of disabled ramblers being attacked by livestock.
