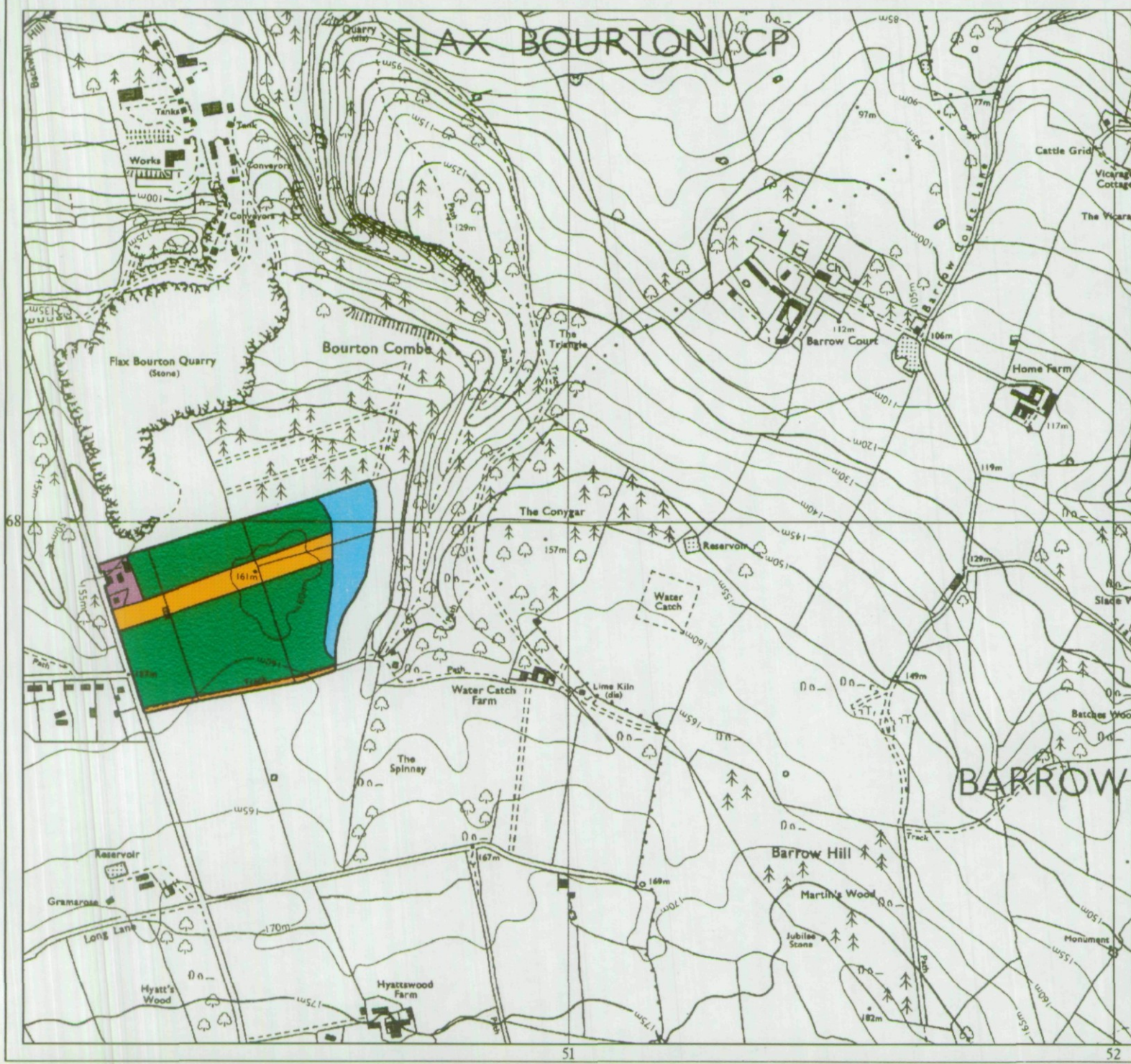

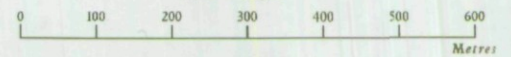

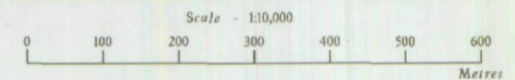





SAMPLE POINT MAP

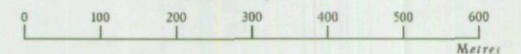
