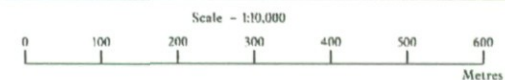

Sample Point Map

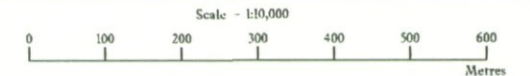

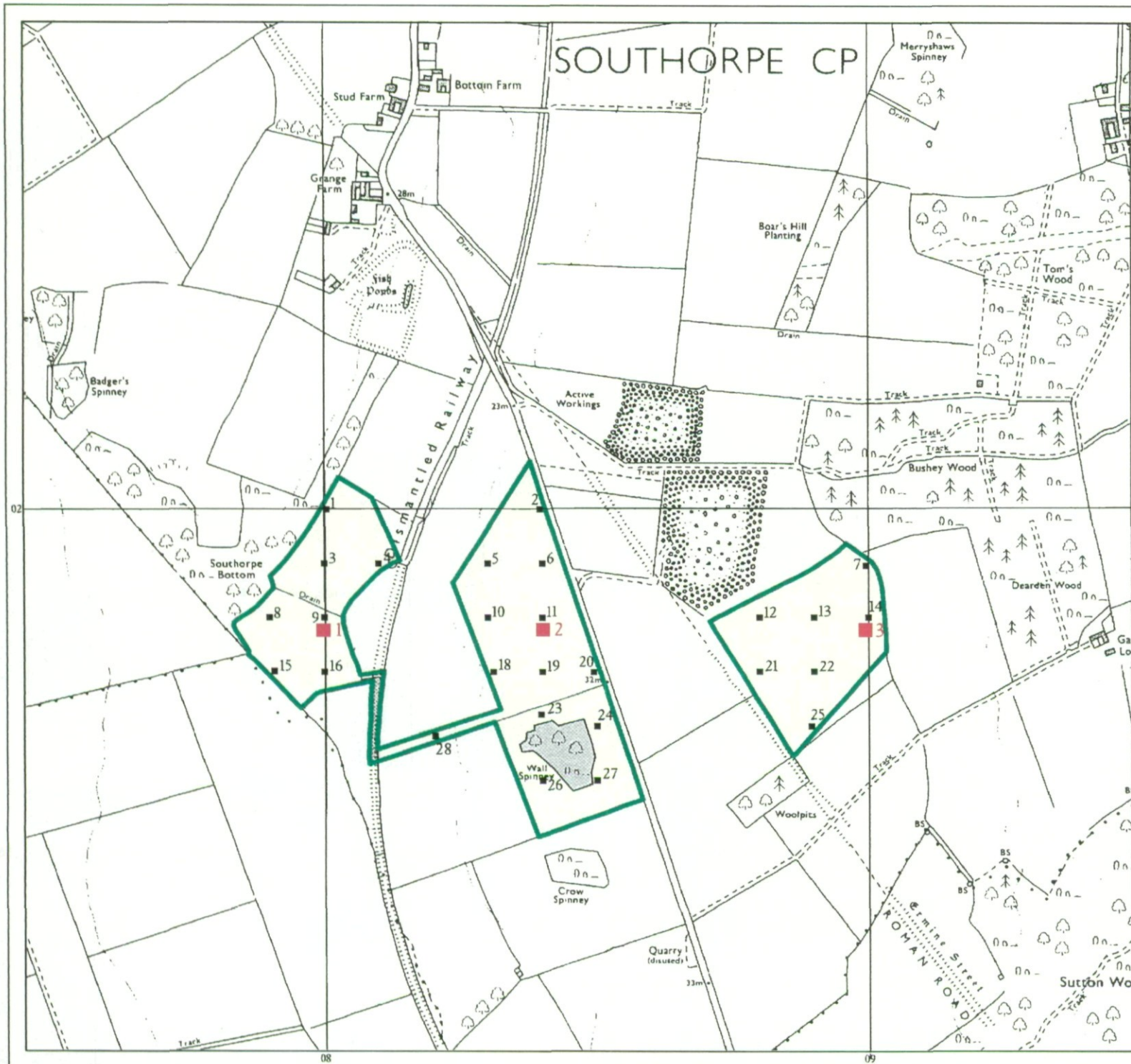

Soil Resources Map

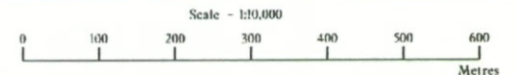
