PAGHAM HARBOUR (WEST SUSSEX)

The site qualifies under Article 4(2) as an internationally important wetland supporting in winter an average of 3045 dark-bellied brent geese <u>Branta bernicla bernicla</u> (2% of the European wintering population). The site also supports nationally important wintering populations: 270 pintail <u>Anas acuta</u> (1% of the British witering population) 781 grey plovers <u>Pluvialis</u> squatarola (3%) and 340 black-tailed godwits <u>Limosa limosa</u> (7%).

The site qualifies also under Article 4(1) by supporting an average of 160 wintering ruff Philomachus pugnax (10% of the British wintering population), and breeding populations of little tern Sterna albifrons and common tern Sterna hirundo.
