This site contains oak *Quercus* sp. and ash *Fraxinus excelsior* woodland, wooded stream valleys, herb-rich grassland and fen-meadow. Peaty mineral soils support fen-meadow comprising purple moor-grass *Molinia careulea* and tufted hair-grass *Deschampsia cespitosa* interspersed with herbs characteristic of this community such as meadow thistle *Cirsium dissectum*, bugle *Ajuga reptans*, lousewort *Pedicularis sylvatica* and greater bird's-foot-trefoil *Lotus uliginosus*. The woodland supports several bat species, including a maternity colony of Bechstein's bat *Myotis bechsteinii*.

Qualifying habitats: The site is designated under **article 4(4)** of the Directive (92/43/EEC) as it hosts the following habitats listed in Annex I:

• *Molinia* meadows on calcareous, peaty or clayey-silt-laden soils (*Molinion caeruleae*). (Purple moor-grass meadows)

Qualifying species: The site is designated under **article 4(4)** of the Directive (92/43/EEC) as it hosts the following species listed in Annex II:

• Bechstein's bat Myotis bechsteinii
