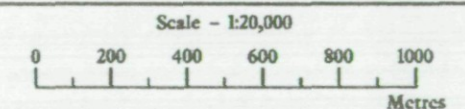

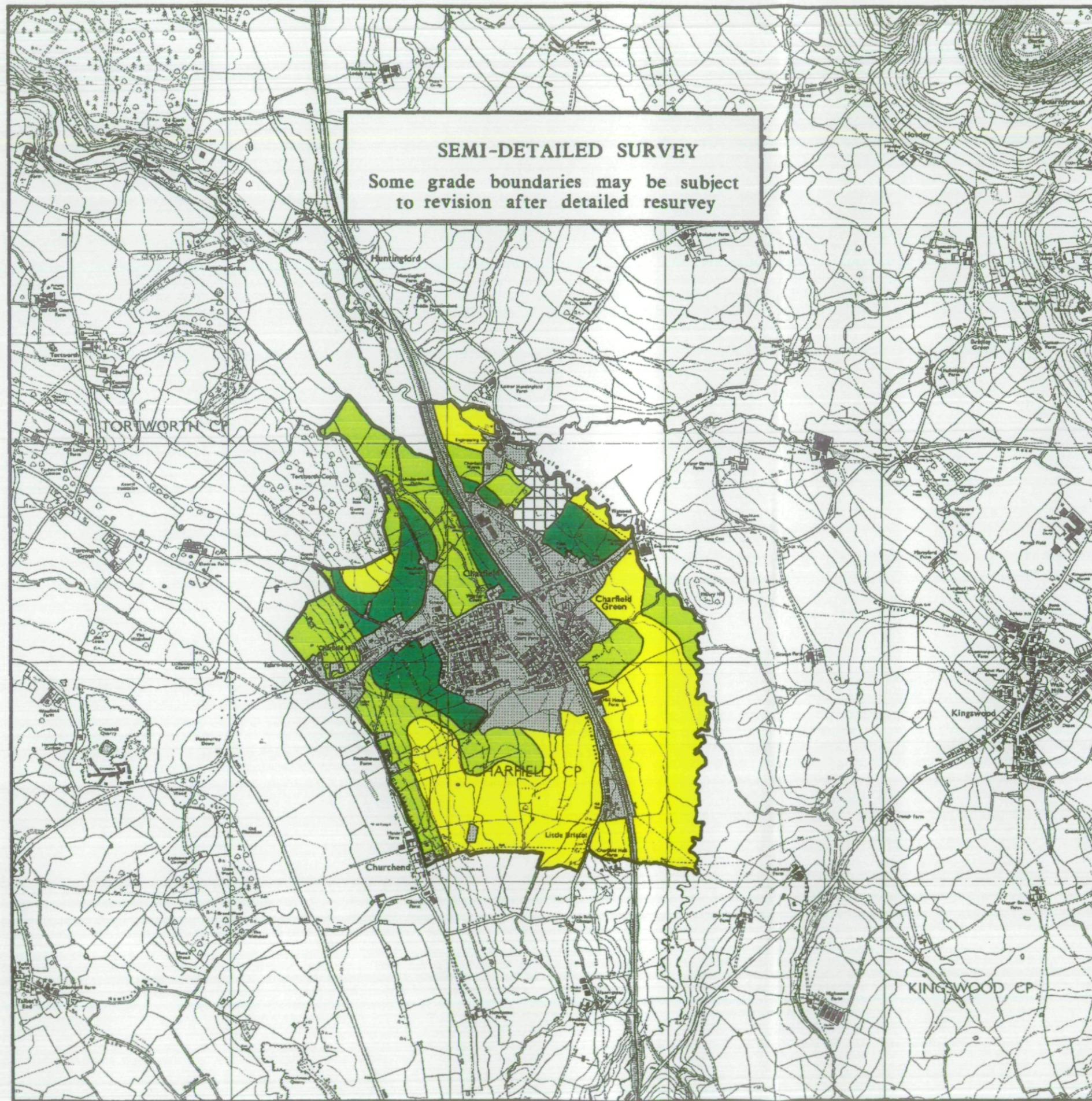

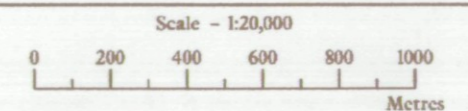
 1 Location of soil pit
