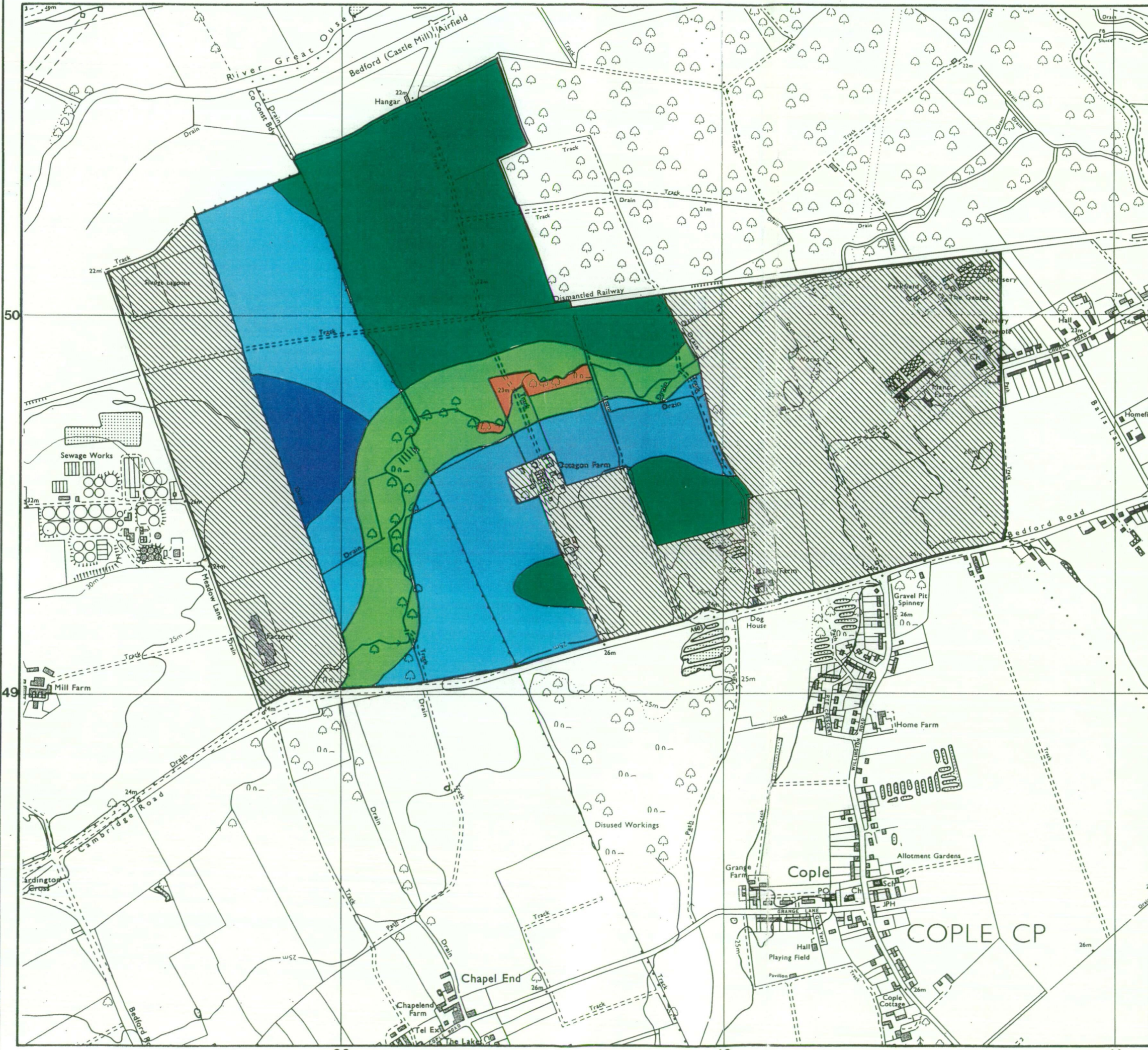

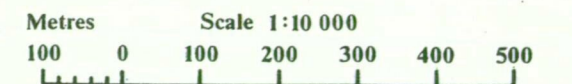

Willington Pit (Extn) Beds

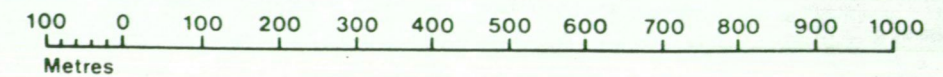


● Location of soil pit

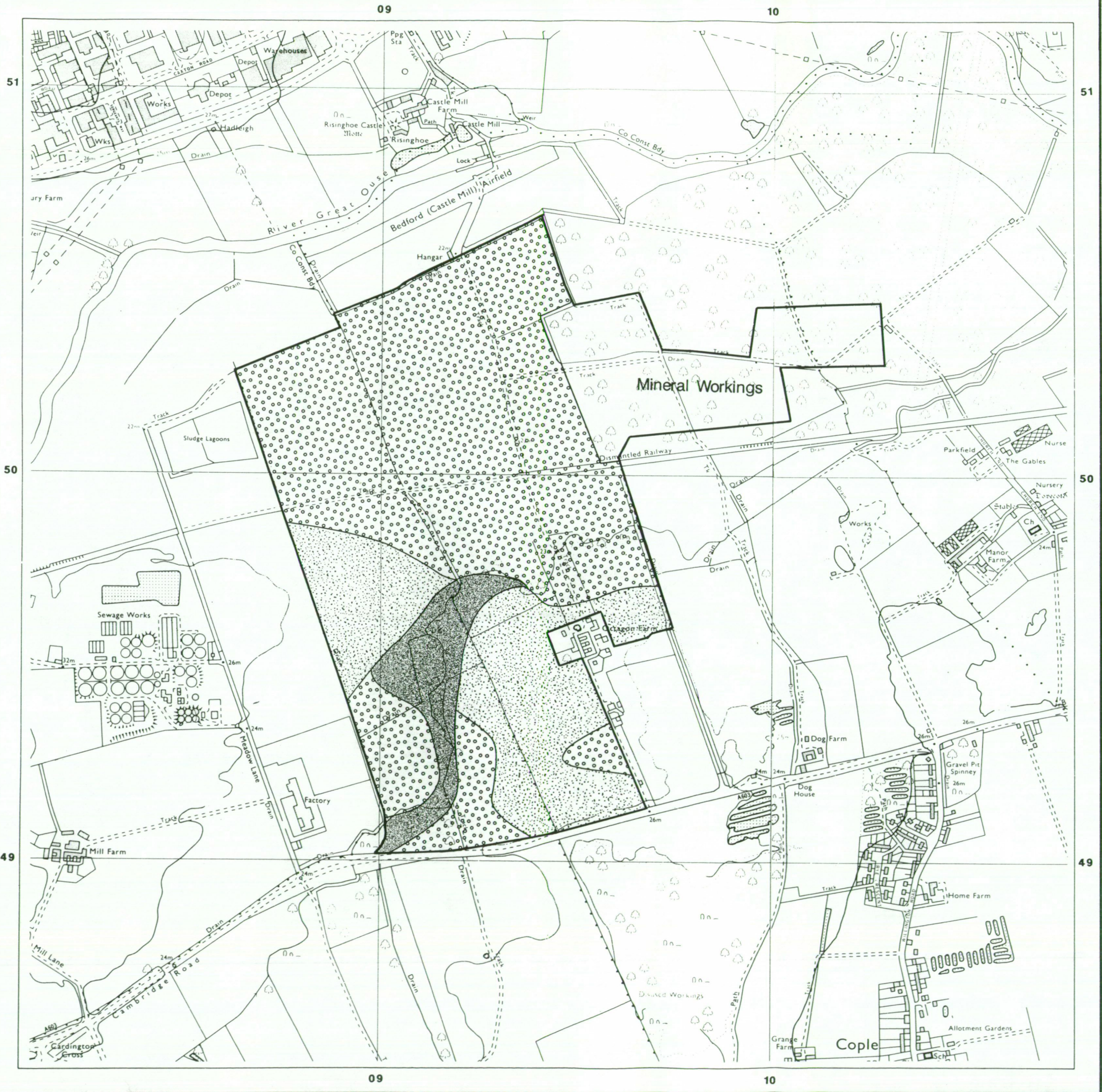

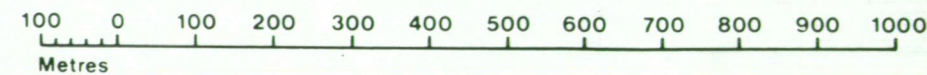
