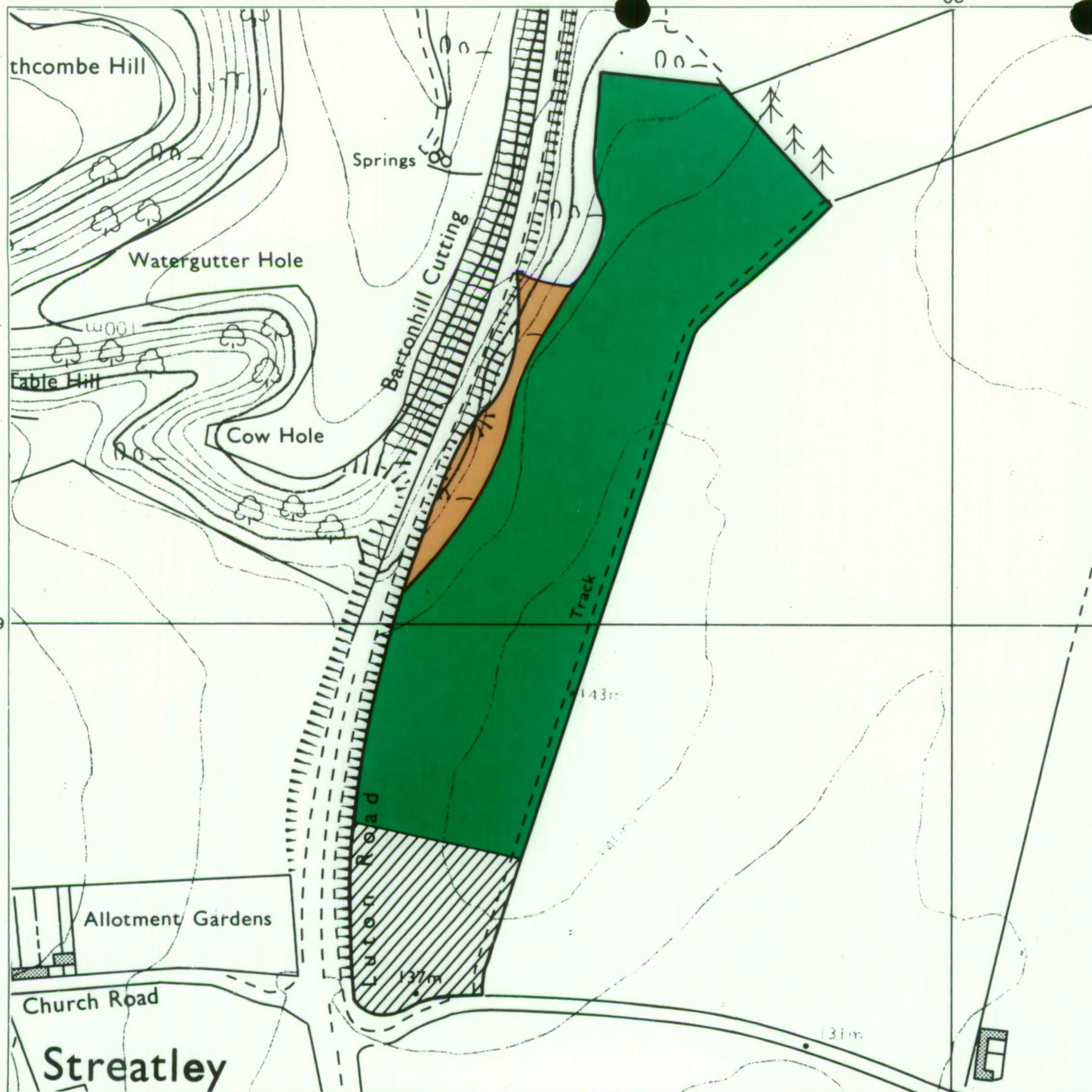

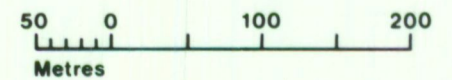

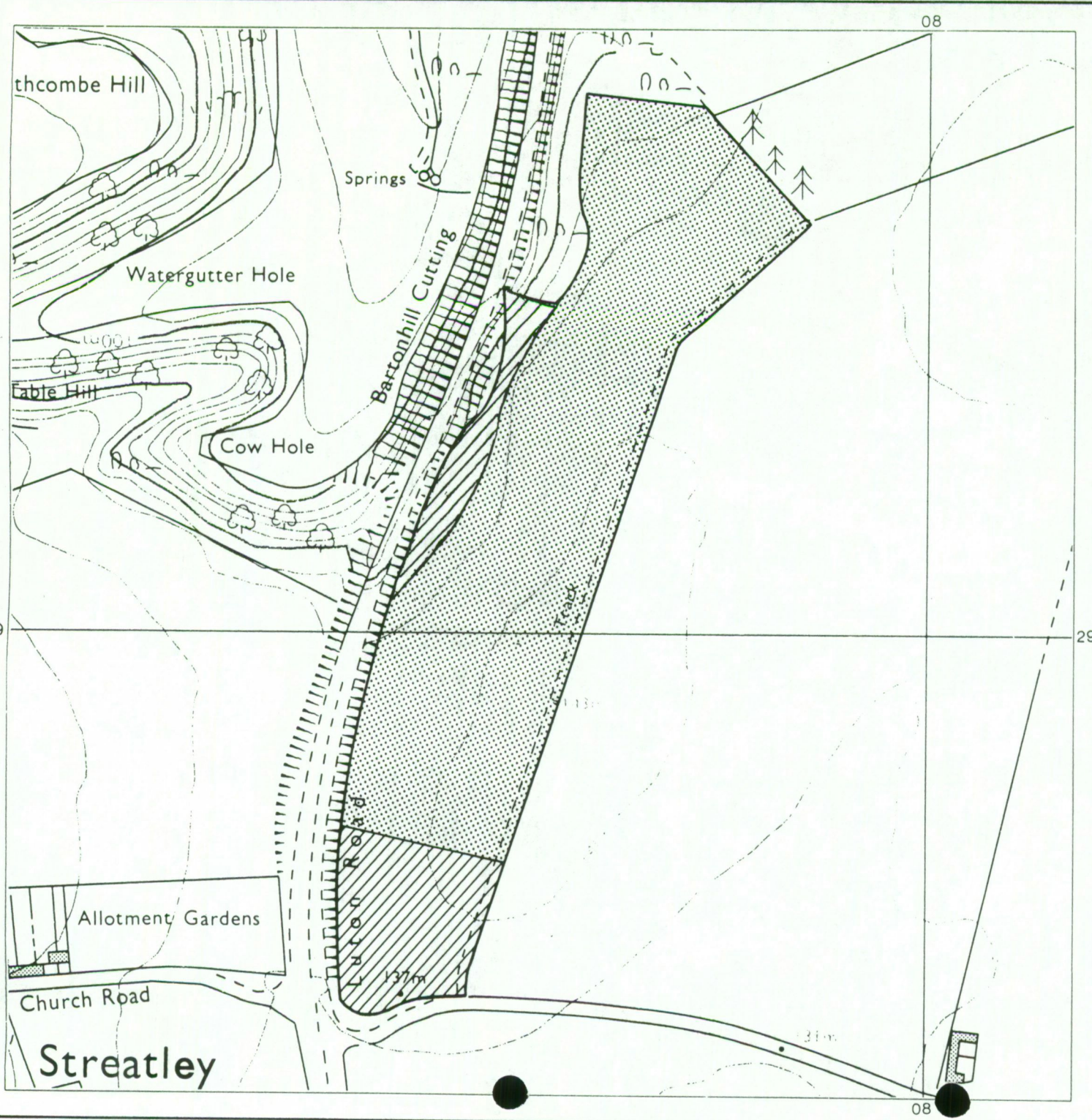

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Distribution of Soil Types Barton-Le-Clay, Beds

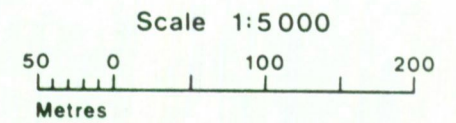

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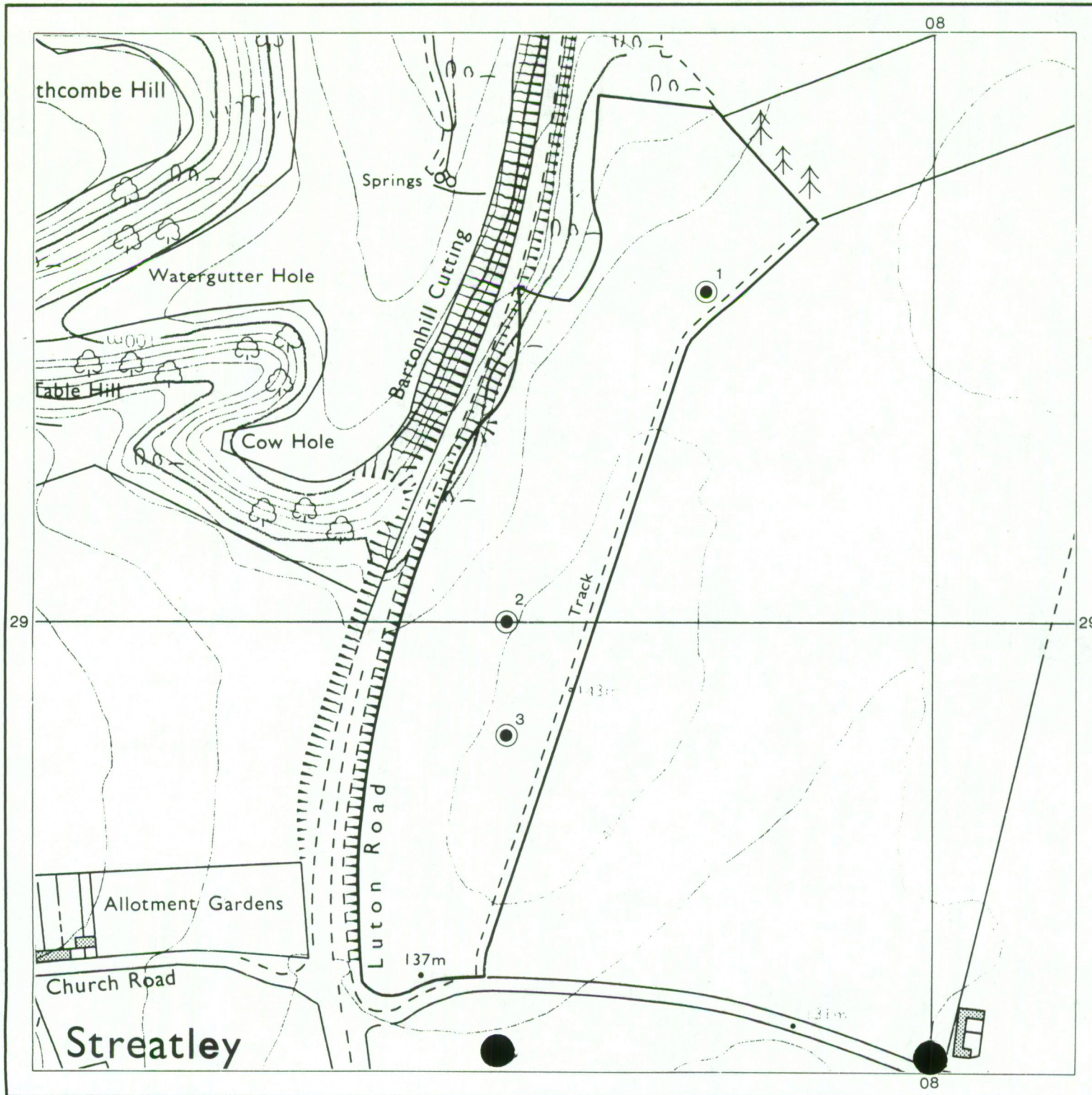
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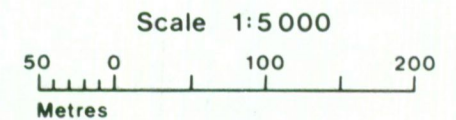

● Location of soil pit

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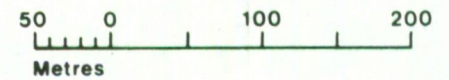
