

The Mosaic Approach

This set of Powerpoint slideshows describes the Mosaic Approach, which is a way of looking at habitats, and their management, that focuses on the requirements of species.

The slideshows are aimed primarily at people giving advice on the management of land for nature conservation. They assume some basic knowledge of ecology and conservation practice.

You should first look at the **Introduction**, and scroll through it one slide at a time.

The **habitat guides** then illustrate how the Mosaic Approach can be applied in a selection of habitats. The guides are interactive, and there are hyperlinks between the slides. Alternatively you can scroll through a guide one slide at a time.
