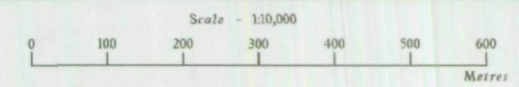







SOIL RESOURCES MAP

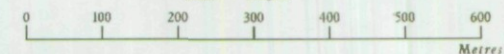

-  LOCATION OF AUGER SAMPLE POINT

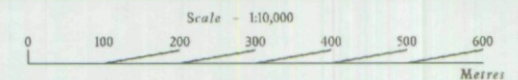
