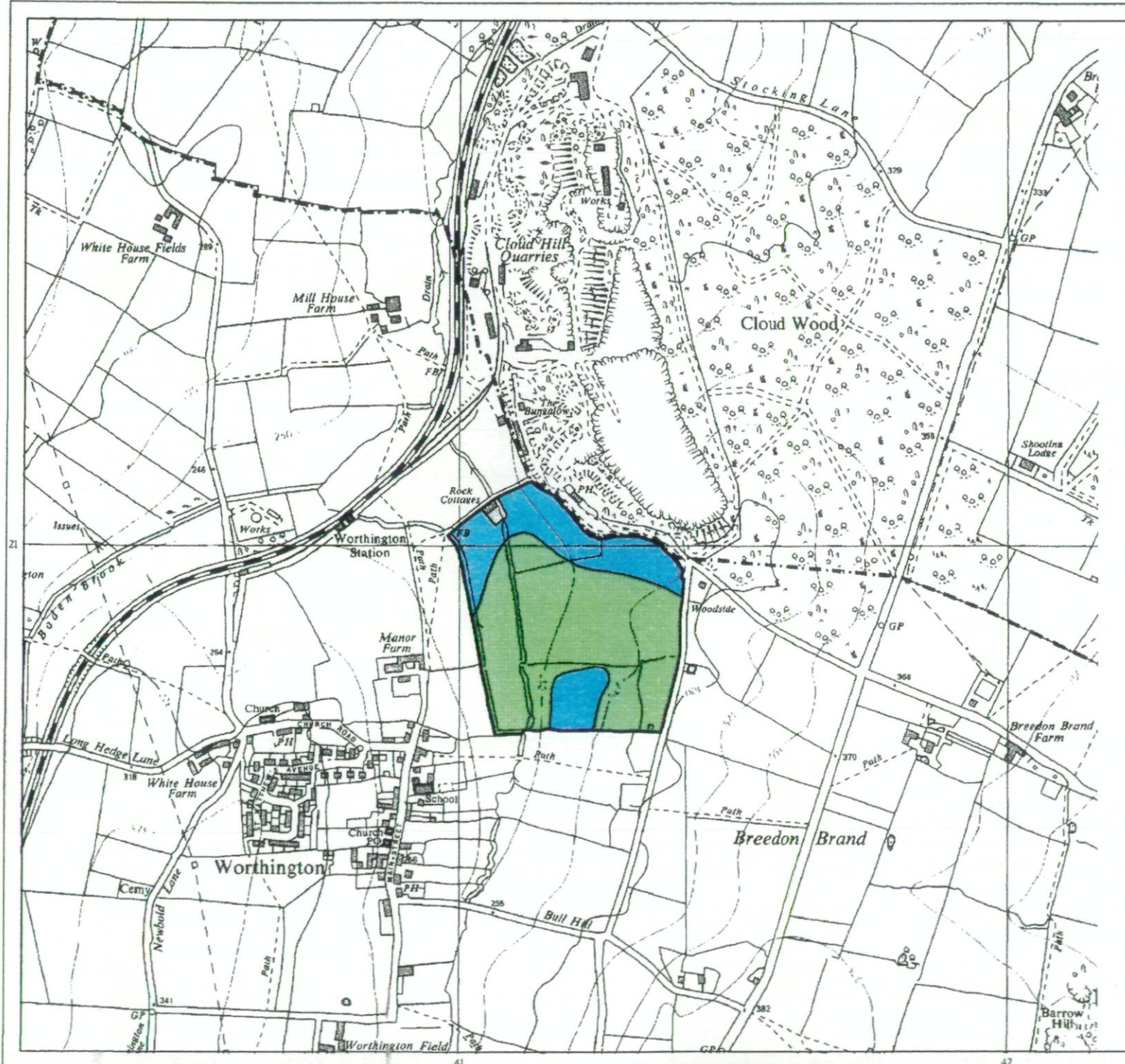

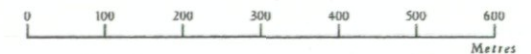

SOIL TYPES

Soil Type	Topsoil	Upper Subsoil	Lower Subsoil
1	0-30 cm Heavy clay loam/clay V. slightly stony	30-120 cm (usually) Clay/silty clay V. slightly stony	Where present Loamy medium sand/medium sand Slightly stony
2	0-30 cm Clay Stoneless	30-120 cm (usually) Clay Stoneless	Where present Medium clay loam Stoneless
3	0-30 cm Medium/heavy clay loam V. slightly stony	30-65 cm Medium/heavy clay loam V. slightly stony	65-120 cm Loamy medium sand variably stony (stoneless - extremely)
