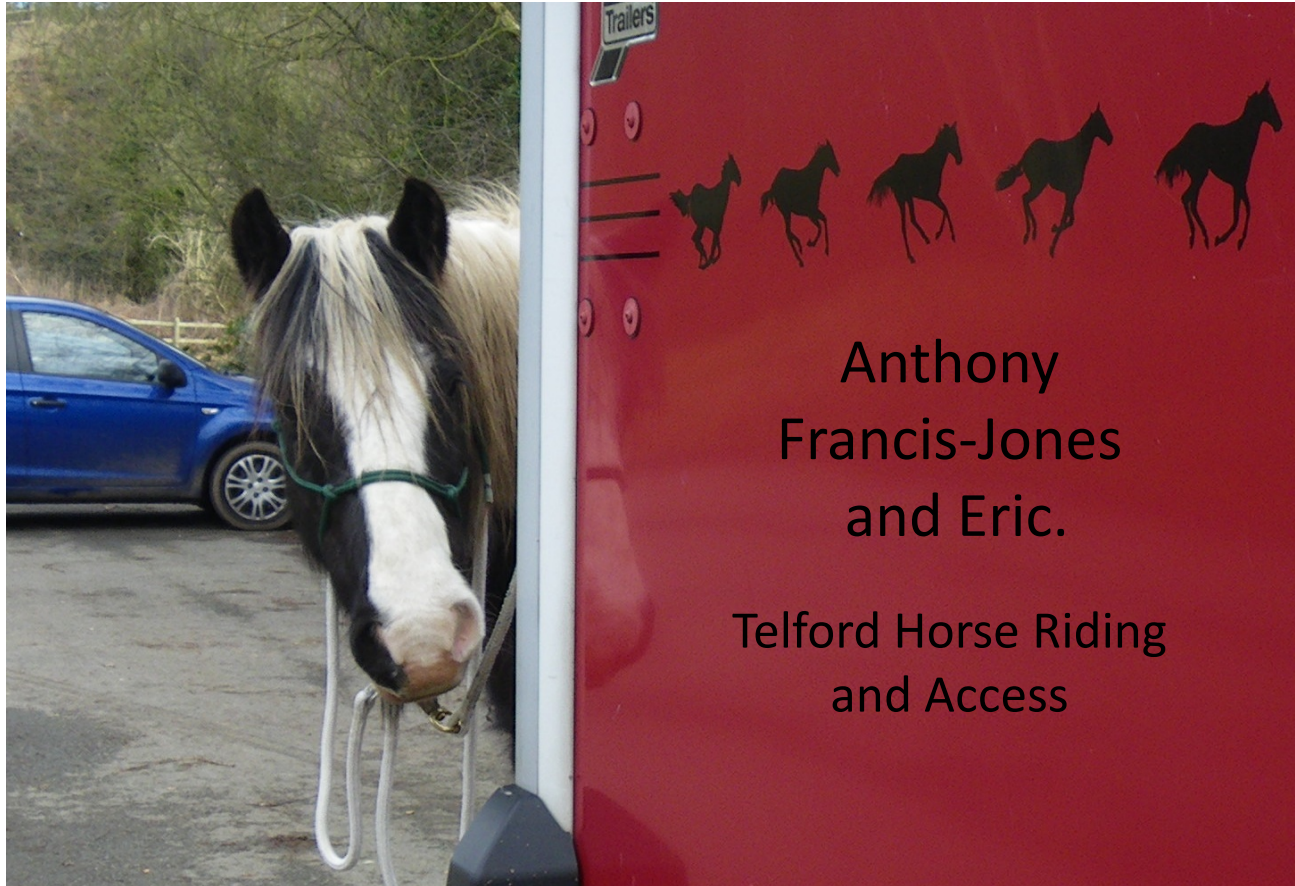


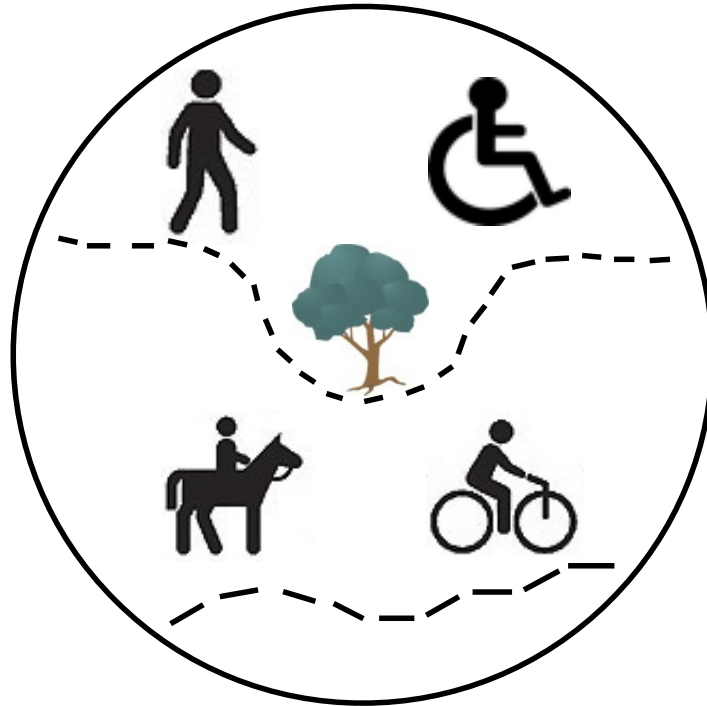

How to begin

Get onto the Local Access Forum

Make sure a senior councillor is on the LAF and takes an interest in PRow

With the Rights of Way Officer and Legal, identify the routes that could be dealt with by Dedication

Get the councillor to take it to Cabinet
