Horse riding path project gets funding

A project to improve access to Lostock Valley in Leyland has received a funding boost.

The Veolia Environmental Trust has awarded the Ulnes Walton Bridleways Association a grant of \$7,000.

The cash will go towards reinstating the currently unusable path, on Moss Side Playing Fields, by replacing its surface with Troptrec a recycled product which is suitable for use by horses, wheelchairs, pushchairs and walkers.

A drainage system, fencing and educational signing will also be installed in the area.

The improvements aim to transform the old bridleway into a multi-use track.







Public Consultation March 2015 Malt Kiln Fold Country Park Age Range Usage


