Introduction

This report describes ongoing radio-tracking research into the barbastelle bat around Ebernoe Common SSSI, and provides advice on habitat management for barbastelle bats.

What was done

Radio-tracking research of barbastelle bats at Ebernoe Common has revealed a fascinating ecology of this species.

Results and conclusions

The increased understanding of barbastelle bat ecology gained from this work has enabled detailed management advice on flight lines and foraging habitat to be set out in this report.
