This report gives advice on managing woodlands for the barbastelle bat and Bechstein's bat.

What was done

Radio-tracking research of barbastelle bats and Bechstein's bats at Ebernoe Common SSSI has revealed much about the ecology of this two species.

Results and conclusions

The increased understanding of Barbastelle bat and Bechstein's bat ecology gained from this work has enabled detailed woodland management advice to be set out in this report.
